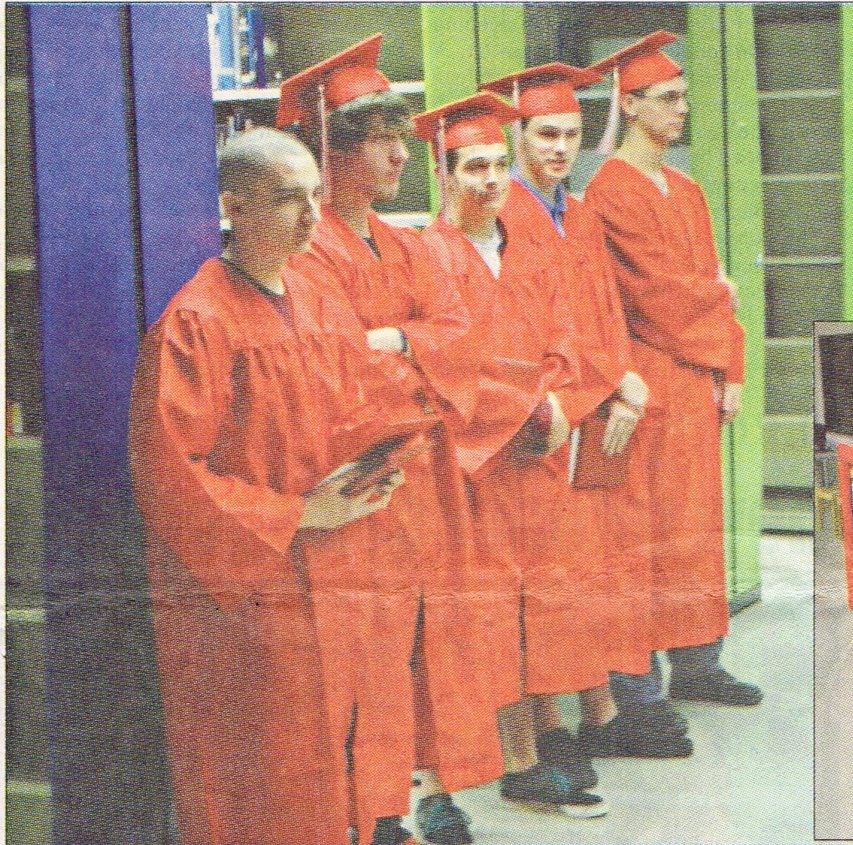


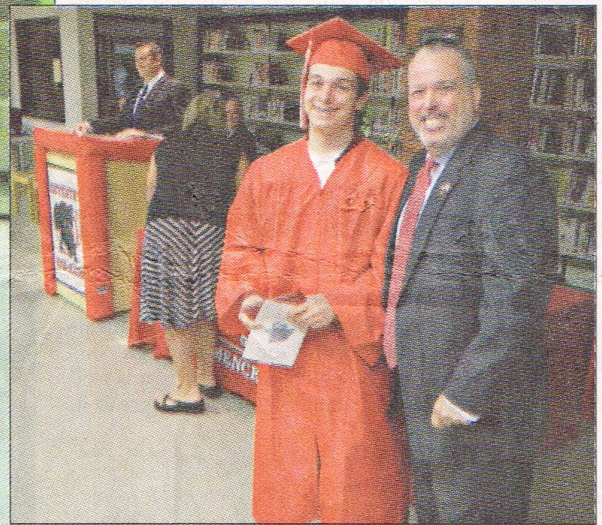

brosio welcomed guests, dignitaries and family for a short and sweet graduation service.

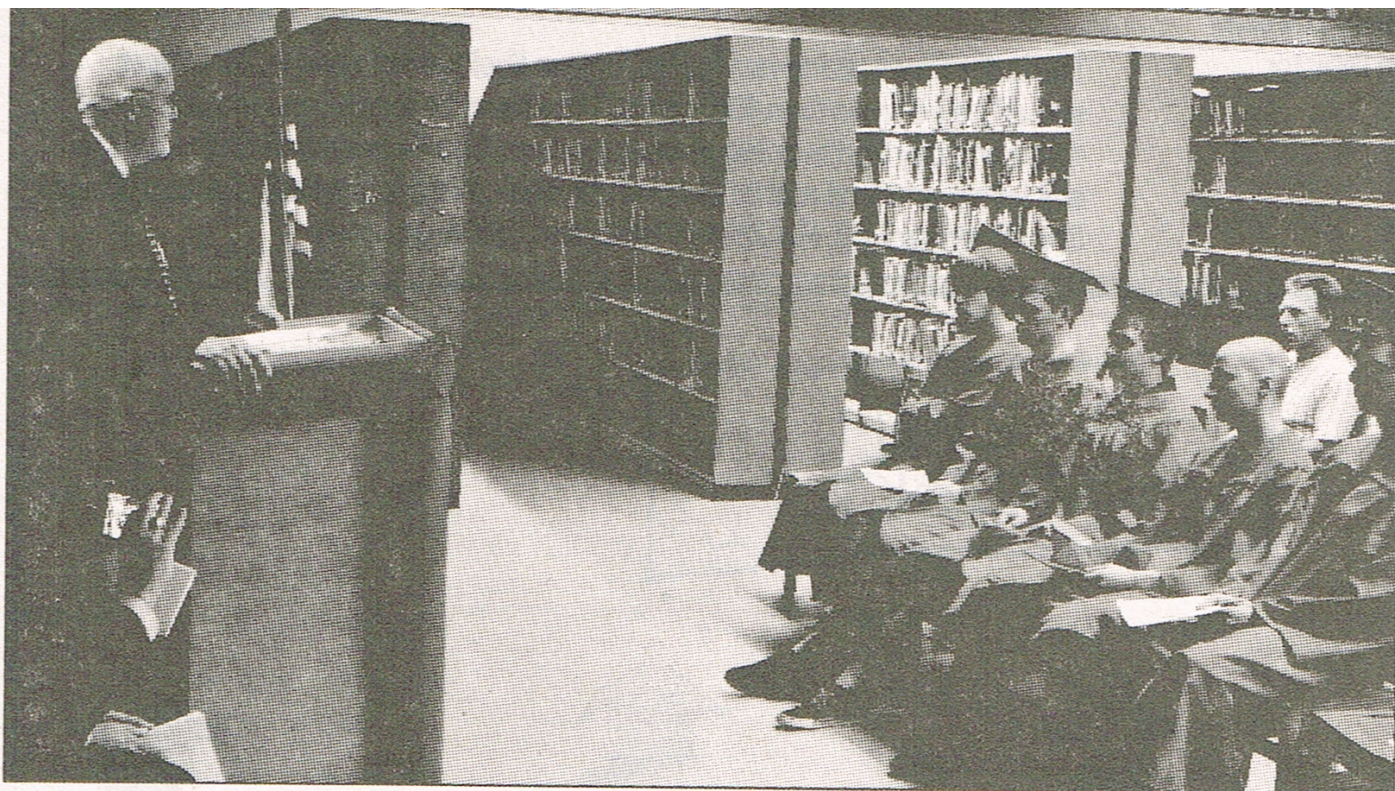
Family members and friends gathered in the audience, cheering for the students while they were congratulated for completed the summer school program and succeeding by achieving their high school diplomas.
