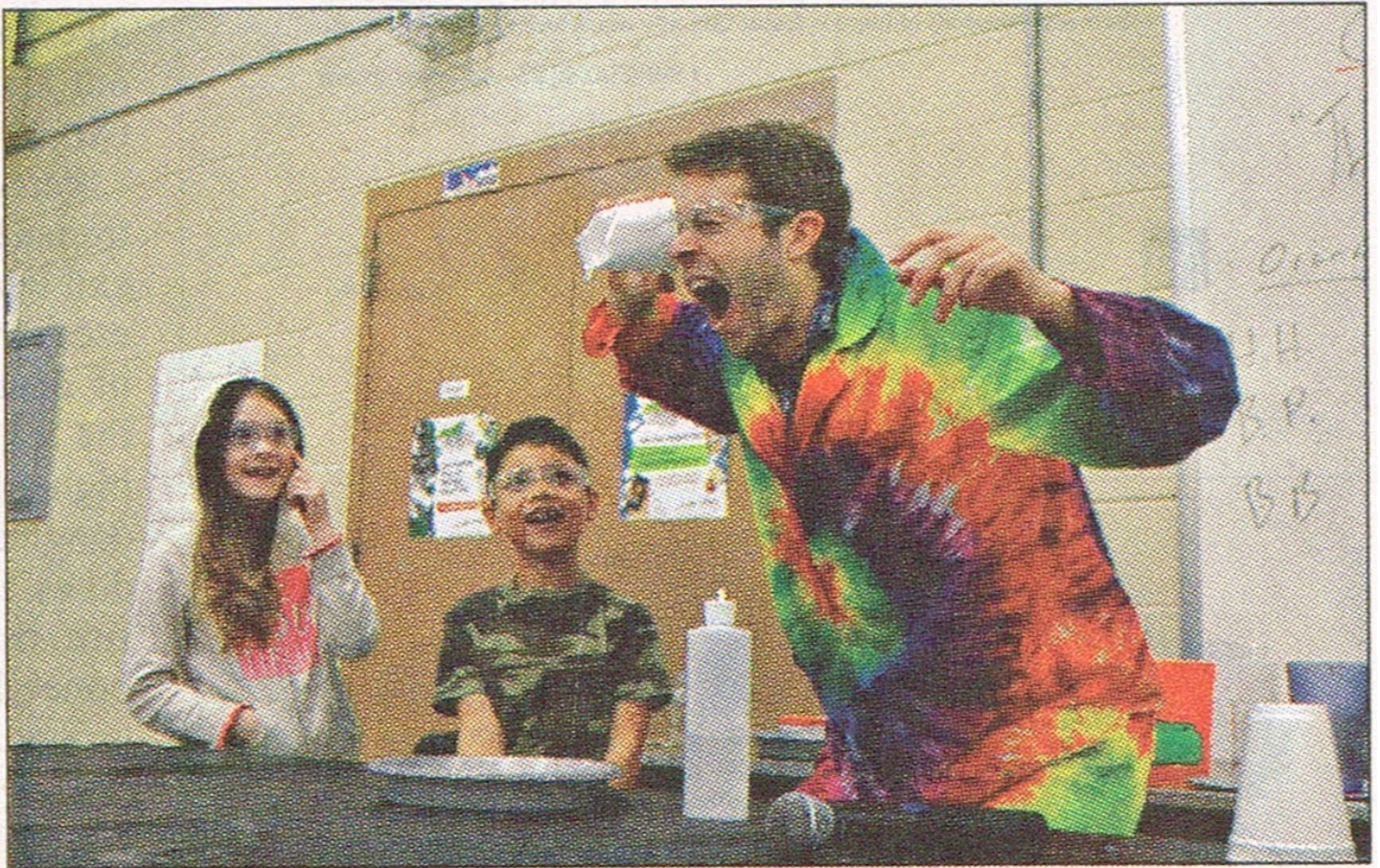

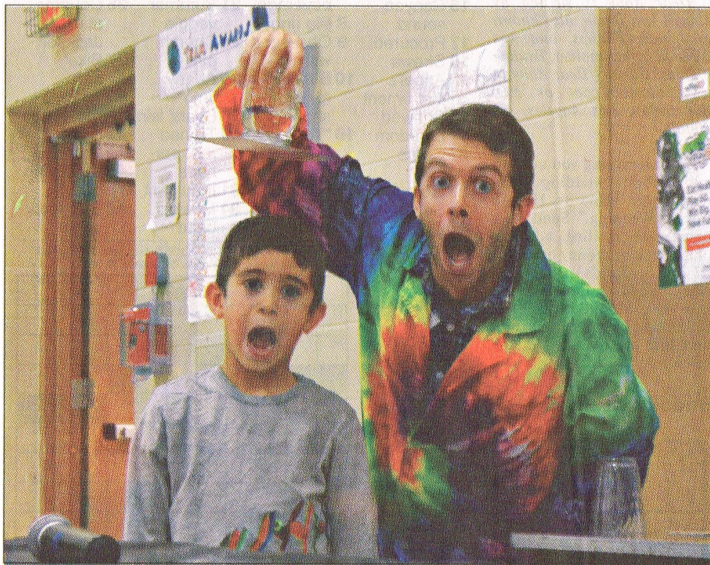
power simple baking soda has when you mix it with other things.
