

## Feinstein Middle School Students Collect "Jeans for Teens"

A group of enthusiastic sixth graders at [Alan Shawn Feinstein Middle School](#) approached their Student Council recently with the idea to have the school join the "[Teens for Jeans](#)" clothing drive. The students "want to make a difference and help kids who need their help."

From Feb. 1 to Feb. 12, the Student Council will be collecting jeans of *any size* (in good condition only) in boxes outside of rooms 108 and 112. At the end of the drive, Mrs. Avedisian, a sixth grade parent, will be picking up the donations and dropping them off at [Aeropostale](#). In return, Aeropostale will give a 25% discount card off a new pair of jeans for each donation.

Students must fill out the sheet outside of the jean collection classrooms with their homeroom, name and team in order to receive their discount card.

According to the "[Teens for Jeans](#)" website, as of Feb. 3, 10,483 schools have signed up to participate in the collection. The school who collects the most jeans will win \$5,000, a pair of jeans for each student and a party.
