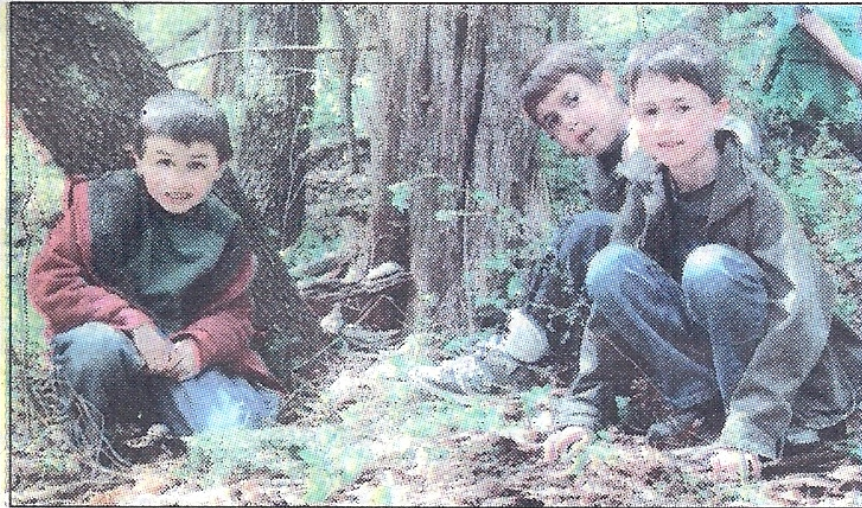


Reading month concludes with special guest in Western Coventry School
