# FIRST: KNOW WHAT SCHEDULE YOU ARE Schedule "A"

In order to be in Schedule "A" you must have been eligible to retire on or before **September 30, 2009**. Eligibility at this point meant the following:

☐ You were at least age 60 with at least 10 years of service

OR

☐ You had completed 28 years of service (any age)



### SCHEDULE "A" ACCRUAL CALCULATIONS

Years of Service	Percent Allowance
Years 1 - 10	1.7%
Years 11 - 20	1.9%
Years 21 - 34	3.0%
Year 35	2.0%

The retirement allowance of teachers in Schedule "A" is based on the average salary of his/her highest 3 consecutive years, and is maxed out after 35 years of service at 80%.

# Schedule "A/B"

In order to be in Schedule "A/B" you must meet all of the following criteria:

- ☐ Hired prior to July 1, 2005
- ☐ Vested by September 30, 2009 (10 years of contributing service; not bought time)



Schedule "A/B" accruals occur from BOTH of the below matrices: Use Schedule "A" for service years on or before September 30, 2009 and use Schedule "B" for service years on or after October 1, 2009

#### Schedule "A"

Years of Service	Percent Allowance
Years 1 - 10	1.7%
Years 11 - 20	1.9%
Years 21 - 34	3.0%
Year 35	2.0%

The retirement allowance of teachers in Schedule "A/B" is based on the average salary of his/her highest 5 consecutive years, and is maxed out after 38 years of service at 75%.

#### Schedule "B"

Years of Service	Percent Allowance
Years 1 - 10	1.6%
Years 11 - 20	1.8%
Years 21 - 25	2.0%
Years 26 - 30	2.25%
Years 31 - 37	2.5%
Year 38	2.25%

## SCHEDULE "B"

In order to be in Schedule "B" a member must not have been vested by July 1, 2005 (again that is 10 years of contributing service; not bought time).

The retirement allowance of teachers in Schedule "B" is based on the average salary of his/her highest 5 consecutive years, and is maxed out after 38 years of service at 75%.

Years 11 - 20	1.8%
Years 21 - 25	2.0%
Years 26 - 30	2.25%
Years 31 - 37	2.5%
Year 38	2.25%
