
#### **Moms Banning Books**

## AFTAction: Support the PRO Act

Protecting the Right to Organize (PRO) Act, which would restore the right of workers to freely and fairly form a union and bargain together for changes in the workplace.

If passed, the PRO Act would:

- 1.Penalize predatory corporations that violate workers' rights.
- 2. Strengthen the right to strike.
- 3.Ensure corporations actually reach a contract with new unions.
- 4.Protect workers against coercive captive audience meetings.

The PRO Act gives private sector workers a voice on the job by making it easier to bargain for fair pay and working conditions. This bill recognizes that all workers deserve the fundamental right to form a union.
